

Annual ANSA High Point Awards

General Rules

- * Performance year from January 1st to December 31st.
- * There are no entry fees payable.
- * Results must be recorded in an ANSA Performance book. Books are available from the Secretary (PO Box 127, Sherwood, QLD 4075).
- * Performance sheets may be forwarded to the Secretary at any time during the competition year, but will not be accepted after January 5th.
- * Points shall be scored from the six (6) best category performances.
- * There are no restrictions on riders as the horses are awarded the points.
- * Points are gained from open competition conducted by any organisation, as well as competitions conducted by ANSA and any of its branches. Competitions restricted to club members only are not considered open competition, and as such no points will be awarded.
- * Local and District events will be awarded the minimum points.
- * Where more than one award is made for a single performance, they will be averaged and the resulting aggregate award will be used to allocate points for that competition. For example, where a hack class is judged by 3 judges, each of whom make an individual award for that class.
- * Junior members riding ANSA horses are eligible provided that the points are gained in open competition.
- * The official recorder's decision is final.

9. Versatile

10. Eventing

Points are gained in any unofficial and official eventing competition including:

- 3 Day Eventing and One Day Events
- Combined Training
- Hunter Trials (excluding Chicken runs)

Points are awarded as follows:

Official / State / National Championships	12,10,8,6,4,2

Annual High Point Youth Awards

- * Open to junior members under the age of 18 years, who are financial members at the time of competition.
- * Open to ANSA registered horses only, owned by a financial member
- * Must compete in at least 2 of the Annual High Point Award categories
- * Riders may ride more than one horse, but details must be shown on the Performance Sheet, as points will be allocated to the 'horse and rider' combination (name of horse and rider to be shown)
- * Aggregate score for the year for horse and rider combination
- * Points may be gained from any type of competition other than Pony Club
- * Full details must be shown on the Performance Sheets and forwarded to the Secretary throughout the year

Annual Pony Club High Point Award

- * Riders must be financial Junior ANSA members at the time of the competition
- * Riders must be financial members of an affiliated Pony Club at the time of competition
- * Horses do not have to be registered ANSA horses
- * Ponies may be ridden
- * Points may be scored from any competition conducted by an affiliated Pony Club and restricted to Pony Club members
- * Results must be recorded on ANSA Performance Sheets
- * Points will be awarded by the Official Recorder for four (4) placings only in each event
- * No points will be awarded for Champion, due to the variation of conditions in different areas
- * Riders gain points, not the horses, therefore a rider may change horses during the year
- * Points will not be scored if Performance Sheets are not completed and returned to the ANSA Office
- * The Official Recorder's decision is final

Annual ANSA High Point Awards

- * Annual High Point ANSA HORSE - Open to ANSA registered owned by a financial member, at the time of competition
- * To be eligible for ALL ROUND ANSA horse, the horse must compete in at least 3 different categories
- * Points shall be scored from the six best category performances (refer to general rules Annual High Point Award)
