## **Changes of Ownership**

Members who have disposed of, or intend to dispose of a registered horse or recorded foal must make an application to the Association on the approved form for records to be adjusted. The Transfer of a horse shall be effected only upon the application of its owner on the form prescribed at time of sale/lease/gift or exchange, and upon such information being furnished by the application as required.

Where a mare has been bred and sold in the current year prior to foaling, the vendor must ensure that the Service Certificate is sent to Head Office with the Transfer Form and Certificate of Registration.

No transfer of a horse in the Association's records shall be effective unless the prescribed document is signed by the transferor, and unless the prescribed transfer fee has been paid by the transferor.

On a family partnership, the transfer fees will be waived on transfers within the family.

When a horse is accepted for transfer, the transfer will be recorded on the Certificate of Registration, which will then be sent to the new owner.

The purchaser of a foal recorded animal who desires that the horse be eligible for subsequent inspection for registration by the Association in his name, must ensure that the horse is transferred to him by the previous owner, and that such transfer is properly recorded within the Association.

Transfer forms, together with the fee and Certificate of Registration must be sent directly to the Head Office of the Association immediately a change of ownership takes place, be the owner a Member or not. Under no circumstances should the Certificate of Registration be handed over to purchasers.
